Stocks to watch on the Australian stock exchange at the close on Tuesday:

■ **AZZ - ANTARES ENERGY:** up 0.5¢, or 0.8 per cent, at 64.5¢
Shareholders in oil and gas company Antares Energy, the target of a takeover bid, were to meet in Perth late on Tuesday to vote on a proposal to sack two members of the board and appoint five new directors.

■ **FFG - FATFISH INTERNET GROUP:** up 2¢, or 10 per cent, at 22¢
The first "internet incubator" to list on the Australian Securities Exchange, Fatfish Internet Group has made a positive trading debut.

■ **KRS - KRESTA:** steady at 23¢
Australia's biggest blind and curtain maker Kresta is urging shareholders to accept a \$34.5 million takeover offer from China.

■ **NCM - NEWCREST MINING:** down 3¢, or 0.3 per cent, at \$11.43
Australia's largest goldminer Newcrest is preparing to fight a class action by shareholders hurt by a massive financial writedown in 2013.

■ **OSH - OIL SEARCH:** up 4¢, or 0.4 per cent, at \$9.54
The ramp up of a massive liquefied natural gas project in Papua New Guinea has fuelled a surge in Oil Search's quarterly revenue. AAP
